

Women to Women Education Grant Application

The Women to Women Grant is for women in need of financial aid to further their education or to improve their skills in order to return to the work force.

GUIDELINES:

1. The maximum grant is usually \$1,000. Larger grants may be awarded at the direction of the Women to Women Committee when funds are available.
2. Written references are required from the applicant's rector or vicar and from two persons who are familiar with the applicant's needs and qualifications. No application will be processed until all references have been received.
3. A previous grant recipient is not eligible to request additional funds.
4. Applicants must be 21 years of age or have achieved junior status in post secondary school.
