Women to Women grants are intended to assist women in establishing and/or supporting business enterprises, programs or projects or obtaining the skills necessary to gain employment. Grants from \$500 to \$5000 that have a positive impact for women are available.

Grants will not be repeated within a three year time period. The Bishop in charge of the area in which the funds will be used must sign the grant application.
